According to MCL 388.1623g(13), the purpose of MI Kids Back on Track is to support programs designed to:

- Address unfinished learning.
- Get students to grade-level academic standards.
- Provide additional academic standards.
- Provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers.
- Help high school students prepare for postsecondary education.

**Program Purpose:** Hudsonville Public Schools will engage our most at-risk students with additional resources to support their learning and boost academic skills.

**Program Summary:** Hudsonville Public Schools will commit all of the state allocated 23g funds with the direct intention to mitigate learning loss via a robust system of Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS), summer learning endeavors for the summer of 2025, and intensive tutoring offered to students who may be at risk for learning loss (school year 2024/2025). These three areas of support are highlighted in the <u>district's continuous improvement plan</u>.
