Technology Bid Review

Patrick Briggs, Assistant Superintendent of Business and Finance, reviewed bids relating to technology upgrades district wide. He is recommending to approve a contract with MOSS Telecommunication Services of Grand Rapids Michigan in the amount of \$62,248.02 (Low Voltage Cabling, \$454,837.88 (Multimedia Systems), \$104,379.26 (Public Address System), and \$168,376.62 (Clocks and Timers) for total value of \$789,841.78. Also, to approve a contract with Parkway Electric & Communications LLC of Holland Michigan in the amount of \$304,273.40 (Building Access System).

Hughes Home

Dr. VanderJagt, Superintendent, reviewed a communication the board received regarding the historical Hughes home on 3848 Van Buren that this district owns. The communication included history, timeline, drawings, and photos of the home. The sender conveyed the importance of preserving the home. Dr. VanderJagt shared that the district had no intentions of razing the home rather working out future developments for Park Elementary to work around the home.

Middle School Courses

Ami Taylor, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, presented the current middle school courses to the board.

Superintendent Evaluation

President Hooper reminded the board that Jay Bennett from Michigan School Boards Association would be providing Superintendent Evaluation training at the November 27 work session. She shared that Dr. VanderJagt would provide his self-evaluation to the board by November 13 along with supporting documentation.
