

2021/2022 "NON-SCHOOL DAY" NOTES



What is a "non-school day?"

A non-school day is a scheduled day off for the district, including teacher trainings, holiday break, winter break, and spring break. An unexpected "non-school day" could occur for a snow day or fog-related delay. Information relating to unexpected non-school days will be included in the Hudsonville Public School closing information, the Early Childhood parent blog, and WOTV 8.

What programs are open/closed on non-school days?

Am I charged tuition for a non-school day if I do not attend?

If the non-school day falls on your regularly-scheduled day, you will be charged your normal tuition for the non-school day. For example, if the non-school day is on a Monday and your child's regular schedule is to attend before school care on Mondays, you will be charged for that before school care.

How is my tuition affected if I do attend on a non-school day?

If your child is in our <u>Full Day Preschool Program</u> and is attending one of their regularly-scheduled days, there will be no change in tuition. If your child is attending on a day that is different from their regular schedule, there will be a charge for the extra day.

If your child is in our <u>Before/After School Program</u> and is attending one of their regularly-scheduled days, you will be charged the difference of our full day charge (\$45.00 per day) minus the tuition you are already paying for that day. For example, if your child normally attends our program on a *Monday* for before school care (\$10.00 charge) and then attends for the full day on a *Monday* of the holiday break (\$45.00 charge), you are charged the difference of \$35.00.

If I sign up for the non-school day, but then do not attend, am I charged extra for the full day?

No, you will only be charged for your regularly-scheduled tuition for that day.

Is hot lunch available on a non-school day?

Yes. Typically hot lunch costs \$2.50 per day. However, your child can currently receive a free hot lunch through the SFSP grant.
