The Early Childhood Center is our community hub for many different services throughout the district. The building provides childcare, preschool, and school day offerings for our Pre K students from Park elementary and overflow from other elementary buildings. It provides non-school daycare for families on snow days and during winter break, if signed up within the before and after school care program, as well as the full day preschool programs.

This building also houses our community Pickleball, Wrestling, and Community Education activities within the gym, and wrestling space at the back of the building. At times, these high school students are moving through the ECC into their specific spaces. It is wonderful to see this interaction of older HPS students with our younger ones. Supervision by our staff members as well as the teams' coaches is consistent to ensure that our HPS rules of conduct and safety are followed.
